Being a victim of crime can make different people feel different things. You might feel sad or angry or scared or lonely. Victim Support can help you.



What is Victim Support?

Victim Support is a charity which helps people who have been affected by crime.



We have trained volunteers to help you.

They will listen to you and give you emotional support.



They will tell you information you need to know.



They will help you with forms and other practical things you need.



What if you have to go to court?

If you have to go to court someone from Victim Support can help you understand what is going to happen.

Witness Service

At court, someone from Victim Support, called the Witness Service, will be with you. They will:



- Listen and talk to you



- Show you around the court



- Tell you who everyone is and what they do



- Give you a quiet place to wait



- Help you with any paperwork or forms



- Give free and confidential help.

From April 1, 2015, the Witness Service will be provided by the charity Citizen Advice.
